Safety Officer Notes:

1. Pocket holsters or Hip-Grips without holster are allowed as long as the shooter can use it safely. **The Clipdraw for Glocks is NOT allowed for safety reasons.** See the Match Director if a shooter requires a belt holster for safety reasons.
2. Calibers less than .32 will be scored as -0 or -5. I.e., -1 or -3 hits will be scored as -5.
3. For concealed holster start stages, those who do not have a holster will use the alternate start as listed in the COF.

Roger Gilchrist – A Horrible Sound

(An Armed Citizen Scenario)

Scoring Method: Vickers

Rounds: 6 (minimum)

Target Description: 1 Standard IDPA target, 1 Non-threat target

Target Distances: 3 yards

Starting Position: Start seated in chair, pistol in IDPA box at P2.

Start and Stop Signal: Start is standard Beep; Stop is last round fired

Procedure:

String 1:

On command, move to P2 and retrieve pistol from IDPA box, then move to P3 and come to freestyle low ready. **On signal**, engage T1 with two rounds to body and one round to the head.

Decock and reload. Transfer pistol to weak hand

String 2:

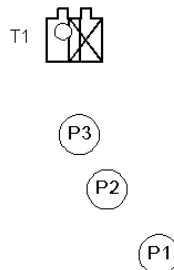
Start at low ready; **on signal**, engage T1 with two rounds to body and one round to the head, weak hand only.

Note: spare ammunition may be carried on the shooter's body.

Scenario Description:

The screams of his pregnant wife—a horrible sound—woke Roger Gilchrist from a dead sleep. He grabbed his gun and ran to the garage, where he discovered that his wife had driven in and stumbled upon a gun-wielding burglar. “Under the circumstances, with him having a gun and standing next to my pregnant wife, I’m not going to wait and see what happens—I’m going to fire,” Gilchrist said. Police say the burglar shot first and Gilchrist returned fire, injuring the intruder. The suspect fled, but was apprehended shortly thereafter. “If [my husband] didn’t have that gun, we would’ve both been dead,” said Gilchrist’s wife. (Daily Press, Victorville, CA, 09/26/07)

Scoring Method: Vickers

Rounds: 7 (minimum)

Target Description: 3 Standard IDPA targets

Target Distances: 5 – 15 yards

Starting Position: Standing at P1, pistol holstered and concealed.

Start and Stop Signal: Start is standard Beep; Stop is last round fired

Procedure:

String 1: Draw pistol, move to either side of doorway and, using cover, and engage T1 with 2 rounds minimum. Reload and remain at low ready

String 2: Starting at doorway, from low ready, engage either T2 or T3 (low targets) with 5 rounds while advancing. All shots must be fired on the move.

Notes:

Alternate start for those without holster – pistol on table at doorway, chamber empty.

Scenario Description:

Three people were shot to death and six were wounded in Colorado on Sunday in two church-related shootings in the U.S. Christian heartland.

A gunman -- described by an eyewitness as dressed in black, wearing combat boots and holding an assault rifle and at least one handgun -- wounded four people when he opened fire in the parking lot of the vast New Life evangelical church in Colorado Springs, Colorado, after Sunday services, police said.

A New Life church security [volunteer - Jeanne Assam] shot the gunman before police arrived on the scene, Colorado Springs police chief Richard Myers told a news conference. – *Reuters* – 12/9/07

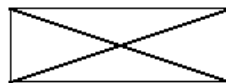
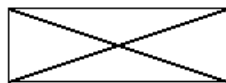

Deerfield Road Rage

Scoring Method: Vickers

Rounds: 7 (minimum)

Target Description: 3 Standard IDPA targets

Target Distances: 2 - 5 yards

Starting Position: Seated in vehicle, pistol on seat, next to shooter

Start and Stop Signal: Start is standard Beep; Stop is last round fired

Procedure:

String 1: Pick up pistol and engage T1 – T2 with minimum two rounds each in any order. When finished, reload if desired, dismount from the vehicle, and maintain pistol at low ready.

String 2: Engage T3 (low target) with 2 rounds to body and one round to head.

Scenario Description:

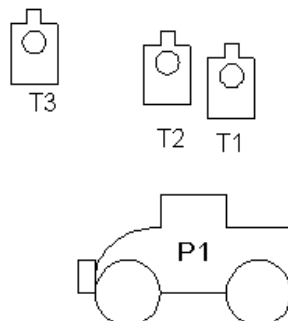
Shouting racial slurs, two men, one with a knife, pounded on Hygens Labidou's truck, yanking on its doors, demanding he let them get at him. Instead, Labidou, a 49-year-old Wellington resident and business owner, pulled out his gun and fired until both men lay bloodied on the road in front of him.

"I shot them!" he screamed into the phone moments later to a 911 dispatcher.

According to investigators, all were travelling [sic] north on Powerline Road in Deerfield Beach when Lonziserro became incensed with Labidou's driving. At the intersection of Green Road, he pulled his truck in front of Labidou's, and leaving his 15-year-year-old daughter in the passenger seat, the 350-pound Lonziserro and Borowsky got out.

"These two men approached him with a deadly weapon in an aggressive manner," BSO spokesman Mike Jachles told the Miami Herald. "Clearly, he was inside his vehicle, and he was clearly within his right to defend himself." Labidou has had a concealed weapons [license] since 1991 or longer, according to state records. *Palm Beach Post* - December 18, 2007

(An Armed Citizen Scenario)

Scoring Method: Vickers

Rounds: 4 (minimum)

Target Description: 2 Standard IDPA targets, 3 Non-threat targets

Target Distances: 3 yards

Starting Position: Start seated in chair at P1, pistol in box at P2.

Start and Stop Signal: Start is standard Beep; Stop is last round fired

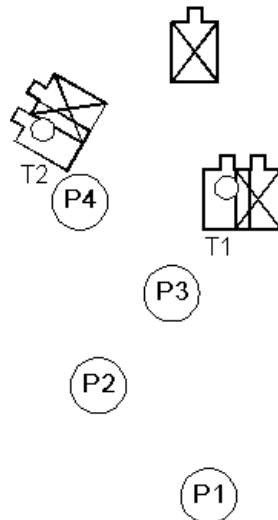
Procedure:

On command, move to P2 and retrieve pistol from box, then move to P3 and come to freestyle low ready. **On signal**, engage T1 with two rounds, minimum. Move to P4 and engage T2 (low target) with 2 rounds minimum or pull out knife and stab T2 twice.

Scenario Description:

Responding to a knock at the door, 22-year-old Carri Humphrey thought she saw another resident of the apartment building through the peephole. Police say that when she opened the door, however, two strangers forced their way in, one of them toting a .22-caliber rifle. Humphrey's roommate, 24-year-old Michelle Reeder, heard Humphrey's screams and ran to the bedroom where she retrieved a handgun. Reeder returned to the front room, where she found Humphrey being held at gunpoint. The intruder then trained the rifle on Reeder and threatened to kill her. In response, she fired several shots, striking her assailant once. The other suspect fled, but the injured intruder continued to struggle, forcing Reeder to stab him. He succumbed to his wounds at the scene as the young women fled to safety. (*The Record Herald*, Waynesboro, PA, 07/02/07))

Scoring Method: Vickers

Rounds: 10 (minimum)

Target Description: 3 Standard IDPA targets, 1 Non-threat target

Target Distances: 2 - 7 yards

Starting Position: Standing at P1 (behind barricade), pistol holstered and concealed.

Procedure:

String 1: At signal, draw pistol and engage T1 and T2 with minimum 2 rounds each, then T3 with 1 head shot.

String 2: Repeat String 1, Strong Hand Only.

Note: Alternate start for those without holster – pistol on table in front of shooter, chamber empty.

Scenario Description:

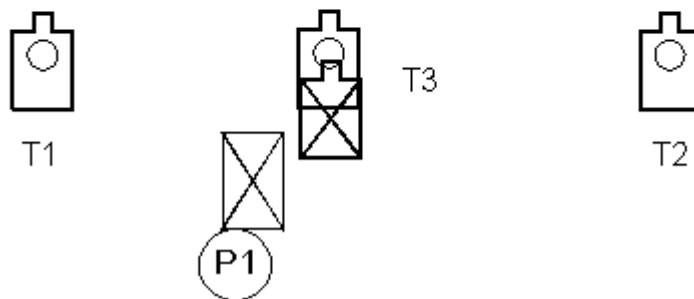
KENT -- For a few seconds, Frank Buell thought he was going to be shot in the head.

One of the three robbers who burst into Kent Jewelry & Loan ordered Buell to his knees and then jammed a handgun against the back of Buell's head, hard enough to leave a knot.

But the single gunshot that startled Frank Buell was from a pistol fired by his father, Nick Buell, who was taking aim at another robber.

Troy Mathis – Driveway Holdup

Scoring Method: Vickers

Rounds: 8 (minimum)

Target Description: 2 Standard IDPA targets, 1 non-threat, partially obscuring T1.

Target Distances: 3 - 5 yards

Starting Position: Shooter facing downrange, standing by driver door of car (low barricade) with hands at sides, weapon holstered and concealed.

Procedure:

String 1: On signal, draw pistol and engage T1 and T2, with two rounds each, in any order.

String 2: Repeat String 1, Strong Hand Only.

Note: Alternate start for those without holster – pistol on table in front of shooter, chamber empty.

Scenario Description:

Troy and Marie Mathis arrived at their Forrest City, Ark., home one night and stepped from their car directly into a life-or-death scenario. According to police, two masked men appeared in the driveway, and one pointed a gun at Marie Mathis' head in a robbery attempt. Troy Mathis fought back, pulling his own pistol from a pocket and firing once. The masked gunman then shot back. When the smoke cleared, the accomplice was gone and Mathis was wounded. The gunman didn't fare as well. He expired a short time later in a nearby vehicle. Reports indicated he had a lengthy criminal record that included robberies, burglaries and weapons charges.
